Norah Hager is a trombonist and a senior at Deer Creek. She has been in the OkMEA All-State Wind Symphony for two years and is a six year member of the CODA All-Region Honor Band. Throughout high school, Norah has received numerous superior ratings at solo competitions and has performed in the Oklahoma Youth Orchestra. In 2022, Norah was a finalist in the OKC Philharmonic Young Artist Competition. In 2023, she won first place in the Brass Division of the Ladies Music Club competition. Next year, Norah will attend the University of Tulsa with a double major in biology and music.





About Paul Compton...

OSU Greenwood School of Music Associate Professor of Trombone, Paul Compton, joined the faculty in 2003. Paul is an artist for Edwards Trombones and Griego Mouthpieces, and a faculty member for the Georgia Trombone Summit. Since 2012, Paul has been an artist for the Trombonanza Festival in Santa Fe, Argentina six times, and he was also an artist for the 2020 Tourbon Festival in Santiago, Chile. Paul has appeared as soloist with the United States Army Band "Pershing's Own", Santa Fe (Argentina) Symphony Orchestra, Santa Fe (Argentina) Municipal Band, Camerata Eleutheria Chamber Orchestra, Oklahoma State University Wind Ensemble, and Oklahoma State University Symphony Orchestra. Paul has premiered numerous compositions for trombone, including works by composers Joseph T. Spaniola, James Kazik, John Cheetham, and Michael Schneider. Paul is a recipient of the OSU Friends of Music Distinguished Music Professor Award, OSU Regents Distinguished Teaching Award, and the OSU College of Arts and Sciences Wise-Diggs-Berry Award for Teaching Excellence in the Arts.

Paul's students have earned over 80 top honors in state, regional, national and international competitions. Studio ensembles have won the prestigious International Trombone Association Emory Remington Trombone Ensemble Competition, International Trombone Association Trombone Quartet Competition, American Trombone Workshop National Trombone Quartet Competition, Courtois Trombone Quartet Competition, Downbeat Magazine Student Music Award for Best Classical Group, IWBC Ginger Turner Brass Ensemble Competition, and the International Trombone Association Kai Winding Jazz Trombone Ensemble Competition.

About Ethan Do...

Ethan is a sophomore trombone performance major at Oklahoma State University, where he studies trombone with Paul Compton and composition with Igor Karača. Ethan is a recipient of the prestigious Max A. Mitchell Endowed Scholarship for Music Excellence, one of the largest awards the OSU Greenwood School of Music offers. Ethan has played trombone in the OSU Wind Ensemble, Symphony Orchestra, Jazz Orchestra, and the various award-winning trombone ensembles in OSU Trombone Studio. In addition, Ethan plays in his own groups, quartet, combo and "Camerata Nouveau chamber quintet." Ethan is a graduate of Deer Creek High school in Edmond, OK, where he studied trombone with Colter Weatherholtz, Darby Cassaday, and Jason Potts.



Ethan is also an active composer, and has had 11 compositions premiered during his time at OSU. Ethan's recent composition *Plus One*, was premiered by the OSU Trombone Octet with international soloist, Peter Steiner, and was subsequently performed by Peter Steiner and the Washington Trombone Ensemble at the 2023 American Trombone Workshop. Other works have had premieres at the 2022 Trombonanaza Festival in Argentina and in New York City as part of a chamber music residency through the NY Philharmonic Educational Partnership Program.
